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CIVIL WAR GRAVES IN CHEBOYGAN COUNTY, MICHIGAN, 1962

These records have been compiled (with the help of several local people) as a part of the work of the Michigan Civil War Centennial Observance Commission (an official State body).

Scarcely any pains have been spared to make the lists of graves as nearly complete as is practicable in 1962, 97 years after the end of the War and 20-odd years after the last death of a Civil War veteran in the area; Nevertheless the lists are certainly not 100 percent complete. Unmarked graves, within or without cemeteries, with no marks of recognition of service; even graves with private headstones with no local recognition of service, and not included in such documentaries as Michigan Census of 1894 Civil War veterans; such as these are probably sometimes missing from the lists.

The circumstances of the author prevented unlimited travel (from his home in Harbor Springs) for personal interviews, much reexamination of the cemeteries in the county, etc. Inquiries by mail were sometimes carefully and adequately answered; to others no answers at all were received.

Concerning the veterans herein listed, two tasks remain to be done: (1) where the military units are not yet learned, to seek out as many as practicable by any means available; and (2) where the dates of death are not yet learned, to seek them out likewise.

In August 1962 the author (at his own expense) made a three-day, two-night trip to Lansing to study, especially for Emmet County, the two matters mentioned in the preceding paragraph. For Cheboygan County only the death records of Ruddock Post No. 224 GAR, Cheboygan, were searched. If the author can make another trip, he would hope to learn much more about the Cheboygan County Civil War veterans. Also, he hopes to consult the death records of the Cheboygan County Clerk's office

5 November 1962

Friday, 15 March 1963: By the courtesy of Mrs. Geraldine Morrison, Cheboygan County Clerk, over four hours' work was accomplished in the Cheboygan County Death Records, which date from 1867.

Wednesday, 27 March 1963: Nearly four hours more work in the Cheboygan County Death Records.

Thursday, 2 May 1963: Went to Indian River and Wolverine; see following Note.

Wednesday, 15 May 1963: Visited Afton, Tower, Devereaux Lake, Maple Grove Cemetery (north of Mullett Lake Village), County Death Records, and Munro Township.

27 May 1963: Original mailed to Chairman, Graves Committee, Mrs. Donald T. Owen, 2540 Oakdale Drive, Ann Arbor, Michigan.

Note: I have searched the cemetery records exhaustively for (1) Oak Hill Cemetery, Indian River, and (2) Silver Lake Cemetery, west of Wolverine. (My search for Silver Lake was made in records of Mrs. Rhoda Whittaker, Nunda Clerk, and Mr. Earl Green, Wilmot Clerk.)

23 October 1963: My wife Louise and I called at Mrs. Whittaker's home in Wolverine; she was not at home.

24 October 1963: Made a trip into Cheboygan County for the following purposes:
(a) To call on Mrs. Meggitt to get as many dates of death as possible from her husband's records, for Pine Hill graves (8 total dates, 10 partial dates, needed);
(b) to call at Recolly's* for dates of death for Henning and Sayles; (c) to search more in County Death Records. * Mullett Lake

I called twice at Mrs. Meggitt's but did not find her at home, twice also at Recollys, but Jake wrote me that he did not have either date. I spent several hours in the County Death Records, rechecked 1867 date for any I might have missed before of no dates and some year onlies. Found d.d. for Augustus Hoot, Mack. Cy, and some (Doolittle, Gerisher, Young) year onlies.

30 November 1963: Phoned Mrs. Meggitt and arranged to call on her in the Spring. I am to phone her before I go.

11 November 1963: Wrote Mrs. Whittaker re (1) Unknown (in Silver Lake) and (2) the Sutliffes.

28 December 1963: Sent a list of 55 names (for the three counties) to National Archives, Washington. All these had government headstones and I requested dates of death where they could furnish them.

22 January 1964: National Archives furnished 44 dates of death, with approximations for three more. Of the 47, 19 were for Cheboygan County. They sent copies of the correspondence to Dept. of Army re the other eleven (incl. the 3 approximations); but because of the nature of their files, Army was unable to help (their letter 3 Feb 1964).

25 January 1964: Asked National Archives for 13 more dates of death. One (Hulbert, Boyne Falls), with govt hs, they sent and I recd 7 Feb 1964. The other 12 were mostly unmarked, but with Co-Regt. known.

18 March 1964: Sent to the Ohio Adjt. General death and burial data on Civil War vets buried in Cheboygan County who served in Ohio units. Also sent them the lists of Civil War vets buried in Cheboygan County for whom I had not yet learned rank-co-regt, asking them to look out in their index to see whether any of these had served in Ohio units. March 25 I rec'd a reply (1) thanking me for the 11 of whom I had sent them data, but (2) saying that none of my 2nd list had served in Ohio units.

23 March 1964: Arrangements being made by phone by Chick Erwin, in the p.m. I drove to Gaylord to see Mr. Jack Walker and search their undertaking (funeral) records to try to get dates of death on Story, Hancock, Lantz, Sutliff, Rathborn. Searched (except after p 141 in vol 1) vols 1-6 (Jan 1915-Oct 1926) in about 2½ hrs; found none of the five, nor any Wolverine funerals. (Rest of #1) and vols 7-11 remain (to near 1940). Stopped in Wolverine on way home; called on Mrs. Whittaker, also on Mrs. Ruth Fullmer, dau of Jas. Sutliff. She told me no Civil War vet named Sutliff in Silver Lake.

25 March 1964: Wrote Earl Green, Twp. Clerk.

27 March 1964 (mailed 28 March): As already arranged by correspondence, I sent Bureau of War records, state of N.Y., list of 18 (incl 2 Storys) for which I had not yet learned rank-co-regt. Cheb. Co.

13 April 1964: They replied that they had record only of Dewitt C. Harrington, and that they had 7 John Wylies.

7 May 1964: Called on Mrs. Fullmer in Wolverine and we went out to Silver Lake

Cemetery. I had a list of 17 Civil War vets census 1894 in Wilmot, Nunda, Mentor, and Ellis Twps., for whom I had not located graves. She volunteered to take the list and work on it; this indeed she did do, making in the succeeding weeks uncounted phone calls and personal visits, and writing many letters. Of the 17 names on my "unlocated" list, she succeeded in learning places of burial for eight, and beside identified (Capelin) the unidentified in the Nunda part of Silver Lake.

25 Aug 1964: Drove to Lansing. August 26: Spent time 9:10 a.m. to 4:40 p.m., skipping lunch, and a short while following morning in the Archives of the Michigan Historical Commission. Found data on Eck (Almon W.), Martin, Shook, Story, (Watkins?), Webb, Whitman, Wilcox. Trip at own expense. Drove home August 27.

22 Sept 1964: Searched County Death Records (and found none) for the following listed in Michigan Census 1894 as Civil War vets living in locations as noted, whose graves I have not found:

In each plot the graves are in single rank, and our numbers are from north to south.

Devereaux Lake

Preliminary Report of the Committee on Michigan Places, Areas, and Objects Which Contributed to the Winning of the Civil War, 1962, p 6, Cheboygan County, calls attention to marker near Devereaux Lake. "This marker furnished by the Federal government through the efforts of E. H. Buck and dedicated Sept 7, 1930, by the American Legion in recognition of Franklin Devereaux's Civil War services. Mr. Devereaux is said to be the only man in Michigan ever killed by a bear."

The writer visited this site 15 May 1963 and found the Government headstone on the east shore of Devereaux Lake, roughly 0.1 mile south of Devereaux Lake Road and roughly 0.1 mile west of Highway M 33. The headstone shows that Devereaux served in the Civil War as Private Co I, 25 Mich Inf. Inscription painted on a wooden memorial plaque gives the date of his death as August 1883.
